

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy explains how Texetta Sp. z o.o. processes personal data collected through this website, including data submitted through the contact form, data processed in connection with website analytics, cookies and the embedded Google Map.

1. Data controller

2. What personal data we process

We may process the following categories of personal data:

Data provided through the contact form

When you contact us through the website contact form, we may process:

- full name,
- company name,
- e-mail address,
- phone number,
- message content,
- any other information you voluntarily include in your message.

Technical and website usage data

When you visit the website, certain technical data may be processed automatically, including:

- IP address,
- browser type and version,
- device type,
- operating system,
- approximate location based on IP address,
- pages visited,
- date and time of the visit,
- cookie identifiers or similar online identifiers,
- information about your cookie consent choices.

The exact scope of technical data depends on your cookie settings and on the technologies active on the website.

3. Purposes and legal bases of processing

We process personal data for the following purposes:

Responding to inquiries

We process data submitted through the contact form in order to answer your inquiry, prepare a response, provide information about our products or services and continue business communication.

Legal basis: our legitimate interest in handling correspondence and responding to inquiries, or taking steps at your request before entering into a contract.

Business communication and relationship management

If your inquiry concerns cooperation, orders, offers, product information or other business matters, we may process your data to manage ongoing communication and business relations.

Legal basis: our legitimate interest in conducting business communication and, where applicable, taking steps before entering into or performing a contract.

Establishing, pursuing or defending legal claims

We may process certain data if it is necessary to establish, pursue or defend legal claims.

Legal basis: our legitimate interest in protecting our legal rights.

Website analytics

If you give the appropriate consent, we may use Google Analytics 4 to understand how visitors use the website, measure traffic, improve content and optimize website performance.

Legal basis: your consent.

Displaying the Google Map

The website may use Google Maps to display our location and help visitors find our office. When the map is loaded, Google may process certain technical data, such as your IP address and device/browser information.

Legal basis: your consent, where required by cookie or tracking rules, and our legitimate interest in providing location information on the website.

Cookie consent management

We use Cookiebot to manage cookie consent, store your consent preferences and document your cookie choices.

Legal basis: our legal obligation to manage cookie consent where required, and our legitimate interest in maintaining a compliant consent management process.

4. Voluntary nature of providing data

Providing personal data through the contact form is voluntary, but necessary if you want us to respond to your message.

Some technical data may be necessary for the proper functioning of the website. Non-essential cookies and similar technologies are used only according to your consent choices.

5. Cookies and similar technologies

The website uses cookies and similar technologies.

Cookies may be used for the following purposes:

- ensuring proper website operation,
- remembering your cookie consent settings,
- measuring website traffic and usage statistics,
- improving website content and performance,
- displaying external services, such as Google Maps.

Cookie consent is managed through Cookiebot. When you first visit the website, you can choose which categories of cookies you accept. You can change or withdraw your consent at any time through the cookie settings available on the website.

Non-essential cookies, including analytics cookies, should not be loaded before you give consent.

6. Google Analytics 4

The website may use Google Analytics 4, a web analytics service provided by Google.

Google Analytics 4 helps us understand how visitors use the website, for example which pages are visited, how users navigate the site and how the website performs. This information is used in aggregated form to improve the website and its content.

Google may process data such as:

- IP address,
- device and browser information,
- approximate location,
- interactions with the website,
- cookie or device identifiers.

Google Analytics is used only if you give consent to analytics cookies or similar technologies.

More information about how Google processes data is available in Google's privacy information.

7. Google Maps

The website may include an embedded Google Map. The map is provided by Google.

When the map is displayed or interacted with, Google may process technical information, including your IP address, browser information, device information and map usage data. This processing is subject to Google's own privacy terms.

The map may be blocked or limited until you give the relevant consent, depending on the website's cookie configuration.

8. Recipients of personal data

Your personal data may be disclosed to the following categories of recipients:

- hosting provider,
- website maintenance and IT service providers,
- e-mail service providers,
- analytics and cookie consent providers,
- Google, in connection with Google Analytics 4 and Google Maps,
- legal, accounting or advisory service providers, if necessary,
- public authorities, if required by law.

We do not sell your personal data.

9. Transfers of data outside the European Economic Area

Some external service providers, including Google, may process personal data outside the European Economic Area.

Where such transfers occur, they should be based on appropriate legal safeguards, such as standard contractual clauses or other mechanisms required by applicable data protection law.

10. Data retention

We retain personal data only for as long as necessary for the purposes for which it was collected.

In particular:

- data submitted through the contact form is retained for the time necessary to handle the inquiry and, if needed, for the period required to protect or pursue legal claims,
- business correspondence may be retained for the duration of the business relationship and for the limitation period of potential claims,
- cookie consent records are retained for the period necessary to document consent,
- analytics data is retained according to the retention settings configured in Google Analytics 4.

11. Your rights

Under applicable data protection law, you have the right to:

- access your personal data,
- receive a copy of your personal data,
- rectify inaccurate or incomplete data,
- request erasure of your data,
- request restriction of processing,
- object to processing based on legitimate interests,
- withdraw consent at any time, where processing is based on consent,
- request data portability, where applicable,
- lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.

In Poland, the supervisory authority is the President of the Personal Data Protection Office - Prezes Urzędu Ochrony Danych Osobowych.

12. Automated decision-making

We do not use your personal data for automated decision-making, including profiling that produces legal effects concerning you or similarly significantly affects you.

13. Security

We apply appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect personal data against unauthorized access, loss, alteration, disclosure or destruction.

Access to personal data is limited to persons and entities that need such access for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy.

14. Changes to this Privacy Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time, for example if the website functionality, legal requirements or external service providers change.
